Dear Residents:

On July 26, 2011 the Camillus Town Board held a public hearing and unanimously approved a resolution to adopt a local law to abolish the office of Receiver of Taxes in the Town of Camillus effective November 7, 2011 and transfer the powers and duties of the office to the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Camillus.

The referendum vote will take place on September 20, 2011 from 12:00 P.M. to 8:00 P.M. Absentee applications are available through the Town Clerk's Office. You can reach the office of the Camillus Town Clerk at 488-1234. If you have any further questions, please contact the Office of the Supervisor Mary Ann Coogan at 488-1335, or your Councilor.

The Town Board has been looking at this as a cost saving option for several years. The anticipated savings the first year is estimated at \$50,000 to \$60,000. If you are interested in the study conducted by Bob Antonacci, County Comptroller, please log onto our website at [www.townofcamillus.com](http://www.townofcamillus.com). According to Mr. Antonacci, over a ten year period the projected savings should be significant. For your convenience, you will still be able to pay your taxes in person, by mail, online, or use your escrow account.






